

Rocky Mountain Conservancy & Rocky Mountain National Park 2025 Call for Naturalist Position to Oversee West Side Fishing Programs

Purpose

The Rocky Mountain Conservancy (RMC) and Rocky Mountain National Park (RMNP) are seeking an enthusiastic candidate with fly-fishing experience to work alongside staff this summer in the Colorado River District. This position would help oversee Rocky's public fishing programs on the west side of the park, based out of Grand Lake, CO. This position would coordinate weekly Junior Ranger Angler programs for families, oversee three accessible fishing events with partner organization National Sports Center for the Disabled, disseminate program information, and maintain fishing equipment. This successful program started in 2022 with a grant from the National Park Foundation. This position would continue to build the program by working closely with park staff to create activities and program materials and connect and advertise within the local community.

Specific project goals include:

- Carry out weekly Jr Angler fishing programs from May – September.
- Create, review, and update program materials and activities.
- Review and update the standard operating procedures for west side fishing programs.
- Coordinate and oversee three events with National Sports Center for the Disabled.
- Maintain and keep fishing equipment organized.
- Disseminate information about fishing programs inside the park visitor center and in the community.

Internship benefits include:

- This position is part time and will provide a pay rate of \$20 hour for 16 hours per week.
- Position dates are May 4 – September 27, 2025.
- Training occurs between May 5-23, 2025.
- Schedule is expected to be on Thursdays and Fridays, with three additional Saturdays.
- Hiring is subject to screening and background check.
